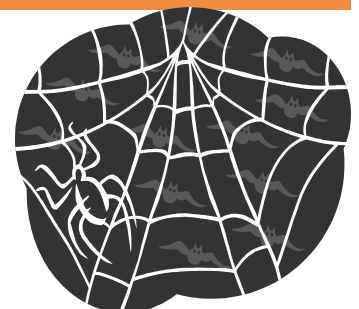
081 Events Scheduling Status
