## RESOURCE GUIDE: Setting Up Student Engagement Attributes in the Schedule of Classes



## **Engagement Course Attributes Setup Explained**

Course Attributes are used to explain something extra about a class in the catalog. Specifically, <u>Engagement Course</u> <u>Attributes</u> explain a uniquely integrative educational experience. Sections will automatically inherit the engagement attributes listed at the course catalog level. If the catalog lists specific **Engagement Activity** and **Engagement Competency** attributes, all sections of the course must list those same attributes. If the catalog lists generic **TBD attributes** for a course, departments may choose to list either specific attributes or generic TBD attributes for each section during open scheduling, or by submitting <u>RCS Section Forms</u>. If the catalog does not list engagement attributes for a course, departments may choose to offer one or more sections within a semester for engagement credit, selecting either specific or generic TBD attributes for the section.

Choose only **one SEA** and **one SEC**. Assigning more or less than one each prevents engagement from appearing on the student's record.

**Step 3:** Select **specific attributes** for sections where **all students will complete the same Activities and Competencies**. Select **generic, TBD attributes** for sections where at the start of the term, **each student chooses the Activity and Competency they will complete**. Instructors must verify the specific Activity and Competency selected by each student when grading at the end of the semester
