Qualifying non-citizen Arizona High School Graduates	Undergraduate Non-Resident 150% Rate Policy for Arizona High School Graduates
<p>A qualifying non-citizen student, other than the nonimmigrant aliens described under 8 U.S. Code § 1101(a)(15), are eligible for in-state tuition under Prop. 308, regardless of immigration status, if the student meets both of the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The student attended any public or private high school or homeschool equivalent while physically present in Arizona for at least two years; and The student graduated from any public or private high school or homeschool equivalent in Arizona or obtained a high school equivalency diploma in Arizona a, i.e., a GED. 	<p>If a student can demonstrate all of the following conditions they may be eligible for a non-resident tuition rate of 150% of undergraduate resident tuition. This rate does not apply to differential tuition, or tuition for on-line, accelerated or distributed programs.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Student is an Undergraduate. Student is not eligible for resident tuition status. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Including qualifying non-citizen Arizona graduates Student has attended high school in Arizona for a minimum of three years while physically present in Arizona (the three years of Arizona high school attendance do not need to be consecutive). Student graduated from an Arizona high school (or attained the equivalent while physically present in Arizona for a minimum of three years). <p>Note: The 150% tuition rate cannot be combined with UA Merit Scholarships.</p>
