<p>A qualifying non-citizen student, other than the nonimmigrant aliens described under 8 U.S. Code § 1101(a)(15), are eligible for in-state tuition under Prop. 308, regardless of immigration status, if the student meets both of the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The student attended any public or private high school or homeschool equivalent while physically present in Arizona for at least two years; and 2. The student graduated from any public or private high school or homeschool equivalent in Arizona or obtained a high school equivalency diploma in Arizona, i.e., a GED. <p>Eligibility for this exception requires you to submit a copy of your Arizona High School transcript (or GED equivalent) to the Office of Admissions. If you have not already submitted this document, please send this electronically to admissions@arizona.edu.</p>	<p>If a student can demonstrate all of the following conditions they may be eligible for a non-resident tuition rate of 150% of undergraduate resident tuition. This rate does not apply to differential tuition, or tuition for on-line, accelerated or distributed programs.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student is an Undergraduate. 2. Student is not eligible for resident tuition status. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Including qualifying non-citizen Arizona graduates 3. Student has attended high school in Arizona for a minimum of three years while physically present in Arizona (the three years of Arizona high school attendance do not need to be consecutive). 4.
