### Tuition Policy for Military Stationed in Arizona Exception

Tuition and residency classification policy for Arizona's three state universities (The University of Arizona, Arizona State University and Northern Arizona University) is set by the Arizona Board of Regents as authorized by the Arizona State Legislature. The general rule for resident classification for tuition purposes includes evidence of 12 months continued physical presence with concurrent permanent intent to be a resident of Arizona. If however, a student can demonstrate **one of the following conditions** they may be eligible for an Arizona residency classification for tuition purposes without meeting the one-year durational requirement:

- 1) the student is not domiciled in Arizona but is a member of the armed forces of the United States stationed in this state pursuant to military orders, OR
- 2) the student is the spouse or dependent child of a person who is a member of the armed forces of the United States stationed in this state pursuant to military orders at the time the spouse or dependent child is accepted for admission.
