



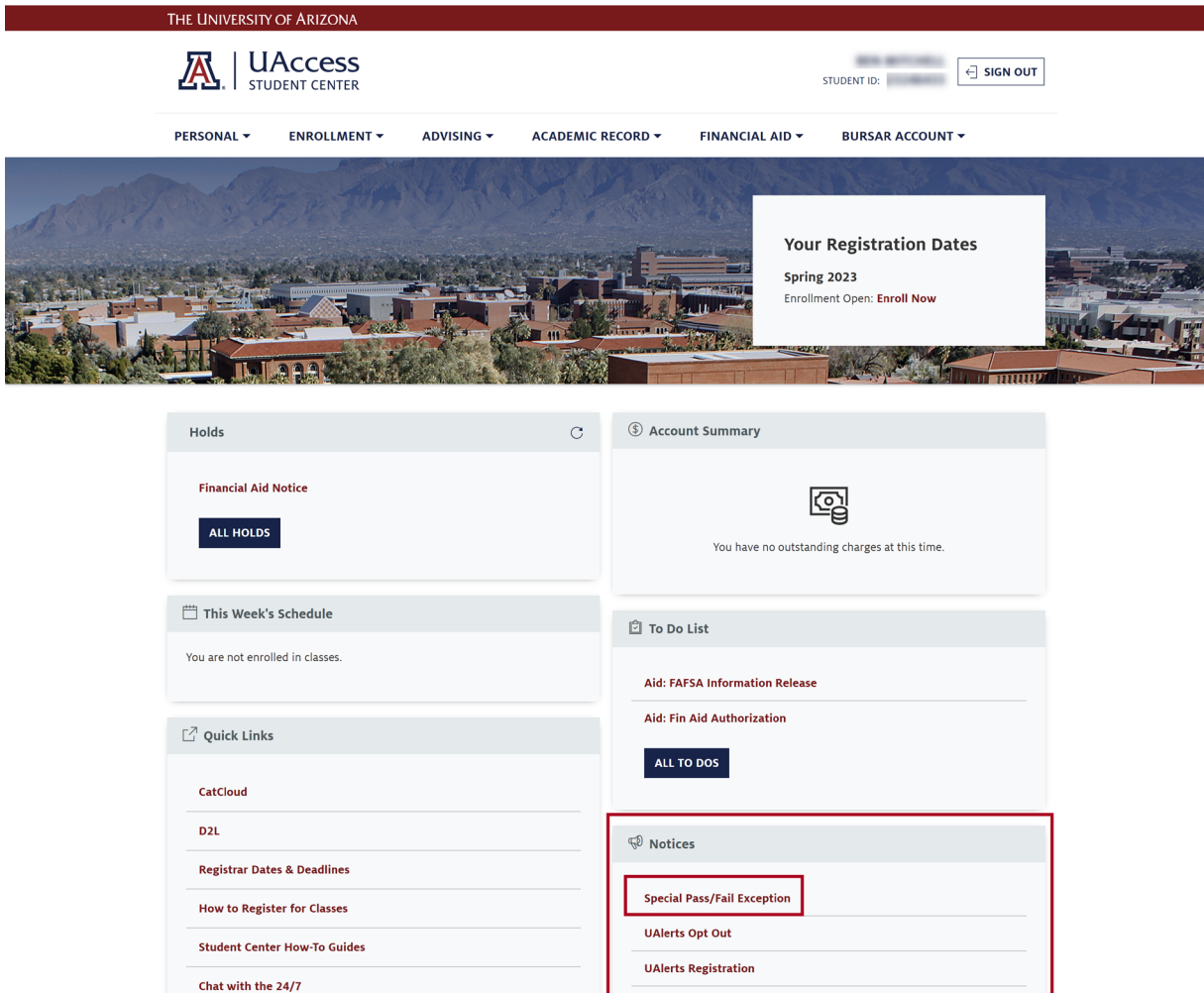

# Special Pass/Fail Grading Basis Exception Request

Follow this tutorial to submit a request to change the grading basis of one or more classes.

# Step 1

# Step 4

## Pass/Fail Grading Basis Exception Request

### + Initiate Request to Change Grading Basis:

For the Fall 2022 term, you are eligible to convert any of your classes to a Special Pass/Fail grading basis. The option is available for any course for the Fall 2022 term, and a passing grade will count toward program requirements and satisfy all academic and prerequisite requirements. You will be able to make this choice after you have received your final grade until Jan. 10, the day before the Spring 2023 academic term. #### Fall 2022 Enrollment

Your fall 2022 classes are below, and as grades are posted, you will be able to opt-in to changing the grading basis, course-by-course, using the dropdown indicator in each row.

Once your selections have been made, confirm your request by selecting the acknowledgement button below, then click Submit.

## Step 5

## Pass/Fail Grading Basis Exception Request

**Courses Ineligible for Changes to the Grading Basis**

The following courses are ineligible for changes to the grading basis for one of the following reasons:

- The course has a grading basis of *Developmental Grading* or *Regular Grades: Not Included in Stats* and is not eligible for a grading basis change.
- A grade of W has already been posted, making this course ineligible.

## Step 6
