Since these section forms will not be processed until the approvals are obtained, expect a longer turnaround time than normal.


Update to Course Fee View in Schedule of Classes

SCHEDULING TIP

Setting Up a 100% Engagement Course

Departments may work with <u>Student Engagement & Career Development</u> to design a <u>100% Engagement</u> course to provide students with a uniquely integrative educational experience. Completing a 100% Engagement course allows students to earn an "Engaged Learning Experience" notation on their transcript.

When setting up a 100% Engagement course, you must always add two engagement attributes: one <u>activity</u> and one <u>competency</u> (see example below).
