Tuition Policy for "Covered Individuals" under Section 702 of the Veterans Access, Choice & Accountability Act of 2014

Tuition and residency classification policy for Arizona's three state universities (The University of Arizona, Arizona State University and Northern Arizona University) is set by the Arizona Board of Regents as authorized by the Arizona State Legislature. The general rule for resident classification for tuition purposes includes evidence of 12 months continued physical presence with concurrent permanent intent to be a resident of Arizona. If however, a student can demonstrate **the following conditions** they may be eligible for an Arizona residency classification for tuition purposes without meeting the one-year durational requirement:

- 1) In the term noted on this form, the student will use the Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB-AD), Chapter 31 Veteran Readiness and Employment, Chapter 33 Post-9/11 GI Bill, Chapter 35 DEA, or The Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship at this institution, **AND**
- 2) The student lives in Arizona, **AND**
- 3) Provides both of the following documents:
 - A. Certificate of Eligibility OR an approved VR&E authorization (Chapter 31 only)
 - B. Proof of living in AZ by providing at least one of the following
