The general rule for resident classification for tuition purposes includes evidence of 12 months continued physical presence with concurrent permanent intent to be a resident of Arizona. If however, a student can demonstrate **the following conditions** they may be eligible for an Arizona residency classification for tuition purposes without meeting the one-year durational requirement: 1) In the term noted on this form, the student will use the Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB-AD), Chapter 31 Veteran Readiness and Employment, Chapter 33 Post-9/11 GI Bill, Chapter 35 DEA, or The Marine Gunnery Sargent John David Fry Scholarship at this institution, AND 2) The student lives in Arizona, AND 3) Provides both of the following documents: A. Certificate of Eligibility OR an approved VR&E authorization (Chapter 31 only) B.
