The Office strives to be a leader and thought partner in creating efficient processes that are designed in a way that supports student success and service excellence.

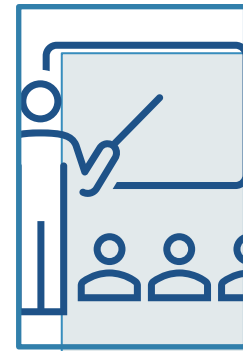

Alternative Credentials

A **micro-credential** is a small program in a focused area of study. A **digital badge** is awarded upon completion.

Micro credentials are:

- Competency based
- Demonstrates proficiency in a specific skill or knowledge
- Validated by an assessment

Micro Credential Benefits

- Provide workforce ready skills
- Available in levels and are stackable to form larger credentials
- Assessable: students and professionals; on campus, online, and hybrid
- Sharable on resumes and on social media
